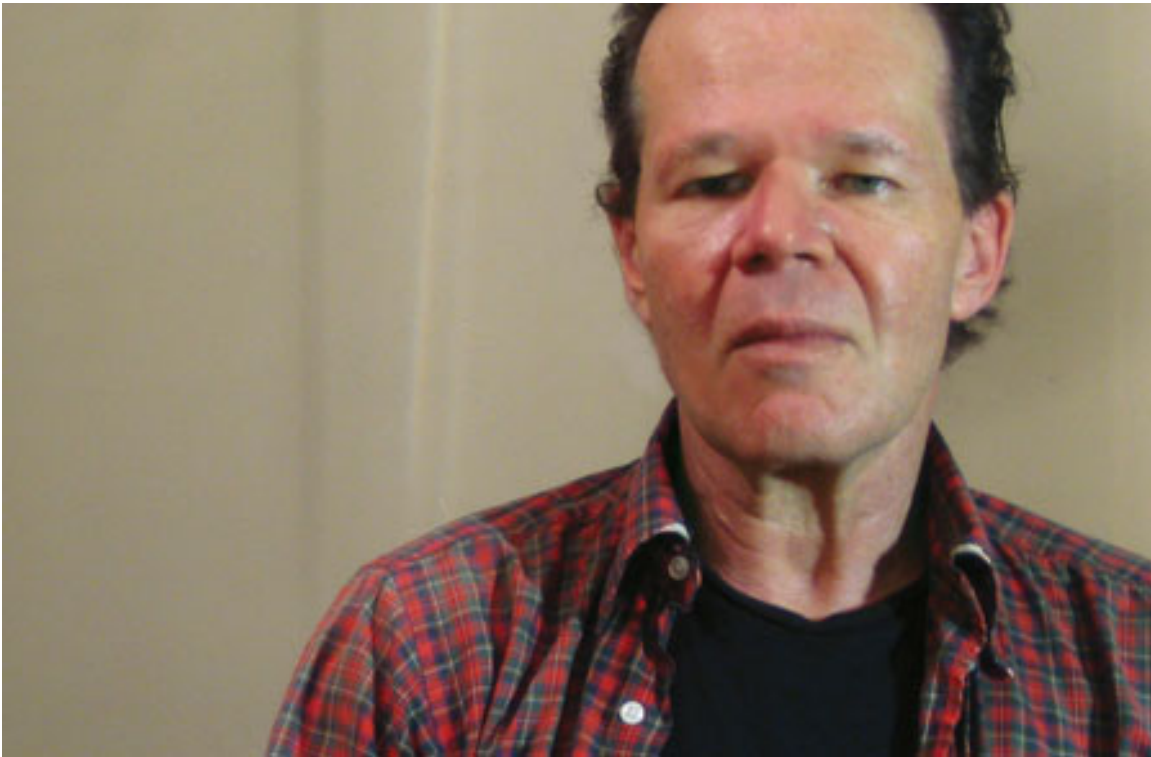


Franz Wright
