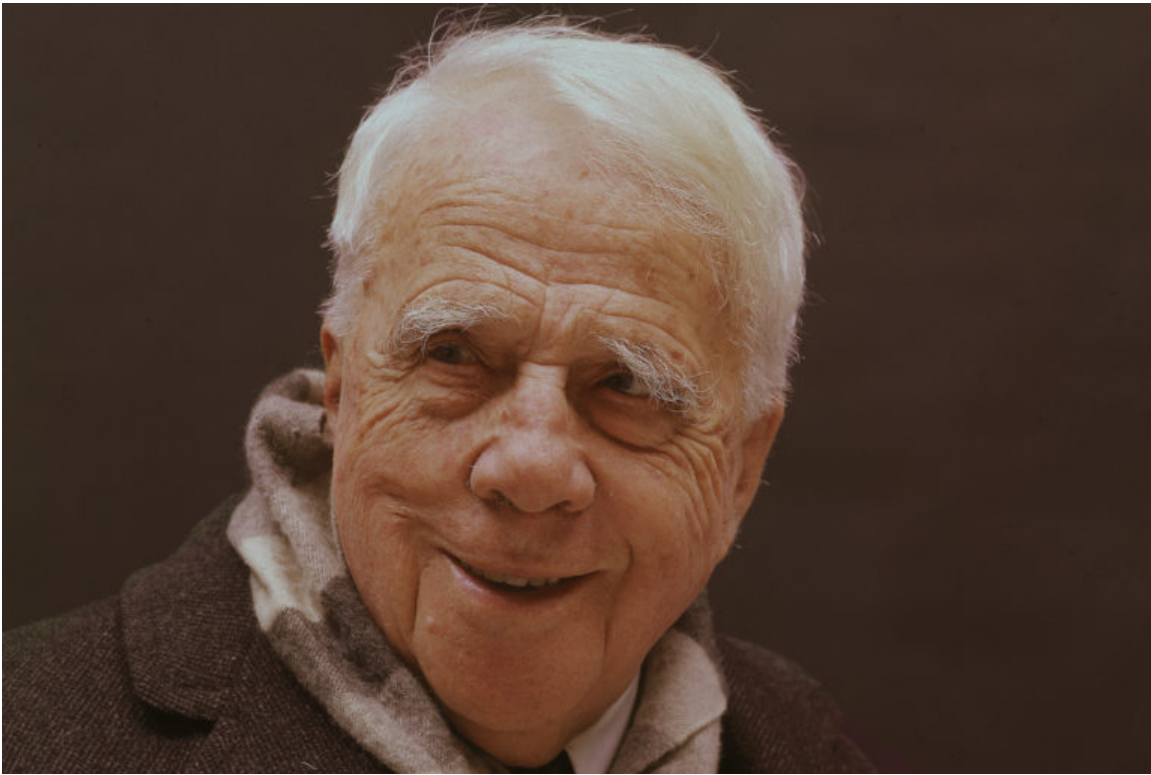


Robert Frost
